Degree Navigator is a handy online tool that allows you to:

- Check if your registered/completed courses satisfy your program requirements.
- See how your registered/completed courses fit into degree programs at UBC's Okanagan campus.

To access your personal Degree Navigator information, follow the steps below.

STEP 1:

- Log on to your Student Service Centre (SSC) account.
- Highlight the Registration tab and select Degree Navigator Okanagan.

Select one of the "Audit" options from the Degree Description dropdown menu to view your report.
