- Review the <u>Partner University Pages</u> for institutions you're interested in to:
 - o connect to the partner's website and find out what courses are typically offered
 - o verify the credit equivalency ratio to determine how the partner credits will transfer back to UBC
 - o see examples of courses other UBC students have transferred back from exchange
- Review the Transfer Credit Process for your UBC campus (Vancouver or Okanagan) to:
 - understand how transfer credits work
 - o make sure you meet relevant deadlines
- Use the following pages on this Study Plan to identify 6-10 courses you could take at each of your top three partner university choices.
 - o note that course catalogues for your term abroad might not be published yet; choose potential courses from the most recent listings
 - o look for courses that are open to exchange students
 - o remember to check the language of instruction
 - o check the level of the course and if there are any pre-requisites
