Participation examination and form (e.g. for school, camp, volunteering, etc.)	\$78.40
Driver's License examination - partial	\$97.30
Driver's License examination - complete	217.00
Third-party examination (e.g. for employment, life insurance, etc.) – partial	\$92.60
Third-party examination (e.g. for employment, life insurance, etc.) - complete	\$223.00
Each additional form (presented at the time of examination) minimum	\$20

**Physician fee - Patients with health insurance from Canada (service not covered by insurance)**

Service	Fee
Wart treatment (excludes genital and plantar warts, as these are covered by insurance) patients with MSP	\$20
Wart treatment (excludes genital and plantar warts, as these are covered by insurance) patients without MSP	\$30
Pap – with out-of-province insurance (Canadian) (includes visit/procedure and tray fee)	\$85.00

**Physician fee - Patients without health insurance from Canada**

Extended visit/counselling (in-office or virtual)	\$147.00
Complete Exam	\$176.00
Pap (includes exam & tray fee) Processing lab will charge additional fees	\$96.75
Injection	\$25.40
Wound Suturing (includes exam & tray fee) - minimum	\$229.60

**\*Students with Quebec Health Insurance:** Students who hold Quebec health insurance are responsible for making payment and submitting their claims to the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec for reimbursement. Reimbursement forms can be found on their website.

**\*If you allow your provincial health insurance to lapse:** You will be billed for the services at the time of the visit. We will provide a receipt, which you can submit to your provincial health insurance plan for reimbursement, once you have been reinstated.

**\*Pap done by Physician – is not covered by insurer when you are away from your home province:** If your Canadian Health Insurance is from a province other than BC, your insurer will not pay for a Pap when you are out of province.
